The inclusion of several Administration & Security related enhancements makes this release a unique one. Besides these, the inclusion of specific Customer Resolutions and another section Looking Beyond v.19.2 go on to show the company's customer centricity and futuristic orientation respectively.

This **Release Notes** document captures the details of all **New Features** introduced in application's current version. To begin with, this release boasts of a completely redesigned and highly customizable Dashboard zone. The application's user-friendliness gets a boost with the introduction of the ability to **Move Transactions Across Claims & LOBs**.

Besides these, there are modules offering improvement in navigating Enhanced Notes and Entity Maintenance screens. Furthermore, Global Level Search capability via the primary menu bar along with new Search Options for Claims & Documents has been provided. The ability to Mark Select Claims as Important or Favorite makes identifying & accessing them easy. Also, the new Financial Summary feature displays key financial data for Claims without the hassle of scouting for them. This release also includes a new feature which avoids the situation where Reserves do not get pushed to the POINT database when Claimant(s) had no addresses. Insurance RISKMASTER brings a new & enhanced Return to Work (RTW) & Medical Disability Guidelines (MDG) interface by integration with ODG by MCG.

This release also boasts of several **Improvements & Enhancements** to its existing feature & modules, user interface and system performance that accord greater agility and improved usability.

With the intent to facilitate business operations, the application now offers the ability to Display Vehicle Model Number on Claim & Reserves screens, along with the ability to Hide Claim Information on Combined Payment Check stubs and a Read Only option for PowerView users. The overall look & feel and performance of the Insurance RISKMASTER application is enhanced with improvements in the Right-hand Pane and Grids along with Multi-currency Compliant Columns on the Scheduled Checks screen. The Auto-checks screen is also enhanced with the introduction of an Allocated Reserves column.

Besides these, the release also introduces enhancements to the **EDI Validation Framework**, **Time and Expense** functionality and the **Life Claim LOB**.

Key Administrative & Security related enhancements introduced in Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 include the Displaying of Type of Person Involved, Administrative Tracking for Case Management Supplementals and the introduction of the ability to Restrict Access to Claim Types.





As part of Customer Resolutions, the process of Defaulting the Role of Additional Policy Insured for POINT Policy Download has been enhanced.

The **Important Information** section covers important guidelines for smoothly running Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 along with information on procuring and using select new features and enhancements.

The newly added section – Looking Beyond v.19.2, provides a glimpse into forthcoming new features and alliances aimed at transforming DXC Insurance RISKMASTER<sup>TM</sup> into a thorough DIGITAL Insurance platform.







## Ability to Mark Select Claims as Important or Favorite

#### Important Claim Tab

A new tab — Important Claim has been added on the left-hand pane. All Claims that have been marked as Important are enlisted under this tab.

#### Star Icon

The star icon can be clicked to select or deselect for marking claims as Important or normal respectively.

#### Note:

- > Only existing or saved Claims can be marked as Important.
- All Claims marked Important will be displayed in the leftand pane under the Important Claim tab.
- Marking Claims as Important is user specific.
- By default, a total of 15 Claims can be marked as Important.
- The number of Important Claims displayed can be customized by editing the ImportantClaimCount key under Utilities > Config Settings

## Displaying Financial Summary Data on Claim Screen

One of the key new features introduced in this release of the application is the Financial Summary popup window which gives an overview of all financials performed on a Claim [Fig. 2]. This financial information represented tabularly and graphically, thus, making the application more user-friendly by negating the necessity to open the Claim to search for financial data.

#### Financial Summary Button



The adjoining button is available on the right end of the Claim header.

The Financial Summary popup is available only on Claim with Reserves across all Claim LOBs. When a Claim (with existing Reserves) is accessed, the Financial Summary popup window opens (maximized) by default and can be minimized by selecting the Minimize Financial Summary command button. This behavior can be changed by unchecking the Show Maximized checkbox at the bottom left corner of the window. If minimized, this window can be accessed again by selecting the new Financial Summary button placed on the right end of the Claim header.

#### **Data Captured**

The following financial data is captured in the Financial Summary popup & displayed as a color-coded bar graph:

- Incurred Amount
- Print Total
- Allocated Total
- Collection Amount
- Balance Amount

#### Note

- The Reserves checkbox must be selected under Security Management Settings to enable the Financial Summary popup.
- If Multicurrency is turned on, then amounts will be displayed in the Claim's currency.
- Settings pertaining to Allocated Amount & Printed Amount must be turned on.



The Medical Disability Guidelines give an estimate of the approximate time required for workers to return to work after various work-related injuries and treatments. The guidelines are specific to the International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems (ICD) codes and take into account that the worker need not lose time away from work if modified or alternate job duties are available or work duties may be safely performed using uninjured limbs, without compromising treatment. ## Easy Navigation to Entity Maintenance

In the previous versions, the Entity search was done to find the relevant Entity. To make the navigation easier, link to the Entity Maintenance screen has been added on the Claimant, Adjuster, Person Involved screen.

To display the Entity Maintenance link on the various screen, enable the same from Security Management System screen.

Go to Security > Security Management System, select the Data Source and then expand Module Security Group. In the Module Access Permission section, expand RISKMASTER to view the access permission granted to the various options and check the Entity Maintenance field.


If enabled, Entity Maintenance icon will be displayed on the Claimant, Adjuster and Person Involved screen [Fig. 5]. Click on the icon to get redirected to the Entity Maintenance screen.

#### Note

In case, the Entity Maintenance Link is disabled from Security Management System screen, then, the icon for the same will not be displayed on the Claimant, Adjuster, Litigation or Person Involved screen.


## Adding Default Addresses for Claimants in POINT Databases

Release 19.2 adds the capability to set default addresses for those Claimants that do not have address information linked to them. This new feature also avoids the situation where Reserves did not get pushed to the POINT database when Claimant(s) had no addresses.

To implement this, a new checkbox **Set Default Values for Upload** has been added under Utilities > Policy System Setup > (select a POINT policy followed by the edit button) > Policy System Web Settings (popup window). **[Fig. 6]**







## Availability of Global Level Search on Primary Menu Bar


To make navigation easier, Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 introduces Global Search that enables searching of Events, Claims, Entity, Policy and <u>Document</u>\* from Claim, Maintenance & Dashboard zones. [Fig. 7]

Now, searches can be carried out using the fields on the **Global Search** popup window (highlighted here with a red border) [Fig. 7] which is accessed by clicking the **Global Search** cicon available on the primary toolbar of the Claims, Events & Maintenance zones.

#### **Customizing Global Search**

The Global Search feature can be applied on various options based on the requirement of the user. To select the search fields, go to Utilities > UI Admins > Searches.

Select the checkboxes against the various Search Links listed on the Searches screen. The selected options will be shown on the Global Search popup.

#### Minimize and Close

The Global Search popup window can be minimized or closed using the standard command buttons

#### Note

Only the fields that are checked will be displayed in the Global Search popup window.

#### Access, Permissions & Viewing Results

The Global Search options works as per the access permission granted from the Security Management System screen. Go to Security Zone > Security Management System > select the Data Source and then expand Module



Security Group. In the Module Access Permission section, expand **RISKMASTER** to view the access permission granted to the various options.

- If General Claim field is unchecked, then, all the access permissions will be disabled for General Claims. In such a case, an error message will be displayed when the user tries to search for it in the Global Search option. The SMS Setting works for all the searches provided in the Global Search.
- In case, there are multiple search results, then, a More Records button MoreRecords will be displayed on the Global Search popup window. Clicking on the More button will display a separate popup with the complete search results. The search fields cannot be left blank. In case, they are left blank and the search icon a in the Global Search popup window is clicked, then, as error message will be displayed.

#### Note

The search works for all date formats and character types.

The Global Level Search works in PowerView and supports all browsers. The search popup window can be moved around on the screen with the help of cursor.


## Displaying Vehicle Model on the Claim & Reserve Screens\*


Earlier, the Vehicle Model was not displayed in the Unit List on the Claim or Reserve screen. To make the tracking easier, Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 enables the display of Vehicle Model in the Unit description on both Claim and Reserve screen.




#### Displaying Vehicle Model on the Claim Screen

The Unit List on the right pane of the Claim screen, earlier, displayed Vehicle Make (Vehicle Manufacturer) and Vehicle Year (Year of Manufacture) only. With the latest enhancement, the Vehicle Model (Vehicle Model Name) will be displayed in the Unit List as well. That is, Vehicle Year, Make and Vehicle Model will be displayed in the Unit List on the Claim screen, in the same order. [Fig. 8].



## Displaying Vehicle Model on the Reserve Screen

Similarly, the description in the Unit dropdown list on the Reserve screen displayed the Unit Number, VIN, Make (Vehicle Manufacturer) and Year (Year of Manufacture) only. Now, Vehicle Model (Vehicle Model Name) will also be displayed in the Unit description of the dropdown list. This enhancement is available only as a downloadable PACKAGE.


The description in the Unit dropdown list on the Reserve screen will now display Unit Number, Year, Make, Model and VIN in the same order as shown in [Fig. 9].



## Option to Hide Claim Info on Combined Payment Check Stubs

Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 introduces the capability to hide or display Claim related information on the Check Stubs of Combined Payment Checks issued to (third-party) Vendors. This feature has been introduced chiefly to keep sensitive Claim related information private.

On the Combined Payment Setup screen [Fig. 10], when an Entity has been mapped with a Bank Account, then all Transactions (across LOBs) for that Entity when Printed, will reflect the same Check number.

#### **Mandatory Fields**

Following are the mandatory fields on the Combined Payment Setup screen > Combined Payment accordion:

Bank Account

Last Name

Following are the mandatory fields on the Schedule Setup accordion:

- Pay Interval
- > Starting On
- Next Scheduled Date
- Next Scheduled Print

#### Note

- The Bank Account & Entity must be the same to generate a single Check Number for multiple transactions for Combined Payments.
- Control Number will be different for different transactions with the same Bank Account & same Entity for Combined Payments.
- Claim information cannot be hidden on regular Checks.


#### Configure Check Stub(s)

Open the Bank Accounts screen for the mapped Bank & select the Check Stocks toolbar button to open the Check Stocks screen. [Fig. 11]

#### Note

If Checks of this Bank Account are to be printed, then there must be at least one Check Stock present on the Check Stocks screen > Basic Options (tab).

#### Selecting Details to Show/Hide on Check Stub

On the Check Stocks screen > Advanced Options (tab) select from the list of fields/checkboxes which must be displayed/hidden from the Check Stub:

Fields on the Check Stub (checkboxes)

- Do not Print Claim Number for Combined Payment
- Do not Print Policy Name for Combined Payment
- Do not Print Claim Date for Combined Payment

If all 5 checkboxes are selected, then individual Transaction Split Details and Transaction Split headers [Fig. 12] will not be displayed. Instead, the following confirmation message — "Transaction split related info will not be available on the Check Stub as all the Claim related info is removed for Combined Payment" will be displayed.


- Do not Print Department for Combined Payments
- Do not Print Event Date for Combined Payment

#### Note

Enabling any 4 of the checkboxes will not disable the individual Transaction Split Details.

## Read Only Option for PowerView

The latest release version of Insurance RISKMASTER allows making the mandatory fields as Read Only. With the latest enhancement, the mandatory fields can now be made Read Only in PowerViews.

To access the feature, go to Utility > PowerView Editor > **Field Properties.**Select any mandatory field to view the radio button to make the field Read Only. [**Fig. 14**]


Toggle the radio button to make the fields Read Only. Whenever the field is made Read Only, a warning message "You are making a mandatory field as Read Only in a PowerView" is displayed.

#### Note:

- By default, the Read Only option will be disabled.
- The functionality works for the supplemental fields and for all the browsers.





Alternatively, the fields can be made Read Only from the Screen Configuration popup window. If the option is enabled from the Field Property section accordion, then, the Read Only checkbox will be enabled in the popup window as well and vice-versa. [Fig. 15]

If the Read Only option is enabled, the field won't be editable for that particular PowerView User. The fields will only be editable if this option is disabled.

## Improved Look & Feel of Right-hand Pane and Grids

#### Right-hand Pane

The look & feel of the Right-hand Pane of Insurance RISKMASTER has been enhanced.

Upon mouse hover, all hyperlinked data texts now get highlighted with a bold orange line underneath them.

This underlining of hyperlinks acts as a call to action. [Fig. 16]


#### Grids

The Grids have also been similarly improved as all hyperlinked data texts in the Grid columns now get highlighted with a bold orange line upon mouse hover signifying call to action. [Fig. 17]



## Multi-currency Improvements for Schedule Checks

The Multicurrency compatibility has been enabled for Scheduled Checks. In the previous release versions, only the payment currency amount was displayed in the printed checks. The exchange rate wasn't saved. As a result, when the Schedule Checks were printed, then, all the currency fields were calculated based on the current exchange rate. That is, the change in the exchange rate wasn't considered initially.

The latest release version of Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 takes this issue into consideration. The currency equivalent amounts and the exchange rates will now be saved in split tables of the check scheduled. The saved exchange rates define the projection of the currency value. With the said enhancement, whenever Schedule Check Installment is printed, new exchange rate is applied, and the currency values are re-evaluated.

During Scheduled Check allocation, the prevailing currency exchange rates will have a direct impact on the Reserve Balance at the time of Printing the Checks. Hence, the Reserve Balance and Printed Amount will be impacted to accommodate prevailing exchange rates.



## Allocate Reserves for Auto Checks

When Payments were scheduled, the earlier versions of Insurance RISKMASTER did not reflect their impact on the Reserve Balance and printing them directly deducted the printed amounts from the Reserve Balance.

Reserve allocation is now available for Scheduled Checks. When Scheduled Checks are created, an amount equal to the value of Scheduled Checks gets deducted from the Reserve Balance and the Allocated Amount will be displayed under the Allocated Amount column.

Once the Scheduled Checks are Printed, then the Allocated Amount will be deducted and the same will be displayed in Printed Amount column.

The values of all Scheduled Checks will be reflected under this column and their sum will be deducted from the Reserve Balance giving greater financial clarity. [Fig. 18]


To make the Allocated Amount column available on the Reserves screen, select the two (new) checkboxes available under Utilities > Line of Business Parameter Setup

- Allocate Reserves when Auto Checks are created.
  - When this checkbox is selected, the Reserve Balance Utility Task will need to be executed.
- > Display Reserve Allocation on Summary Screens.
  - This checkbox will automatically get checked when the "Allocate Reserves when Auto Checks are created" checkbox is selected.

#### Notes

- All Transactions in Released status (not Printed) will be displayed under the Allocated Amount column.
- Printed Check amounts are deducted from the Allocated Amount & displayed under the Printed column.
- With Allocated Auto Checks the sum of Allocated Amount and Printed Amount column would reflect the reduction in Reserve Balance. The Paid column will display Auto Checks only when they're released or Printed.

## Enhanced EDI Validation Framework\*


Unlike the previous versions, Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 now offers an Abort button on the Started Jobs on EDI Validation Framework. An Abort button has been added beside SROI and FROI buttons. However, the status of the Abort button disabled when the status of the jobs is anything other than Started. The started jobs can be aborted whenever required. Additionally, the Abort button will be displayed on the EDI Validation Framework Page. [Fig. 19]





Earlier, the status of the FROI/SROI validation for the Claim that was completed with Error was displayed as Started. In the latest version, the status of these validations will remain Started and can be aborted with latest functionality.

The option to download the validation file will be available only when the status is Completed with Validation Error. The download option will be displayed in the EDI Validation Framework Page. Additionally, an error will be thrown if EDI Extract System EXE file is not placed at the correct location.

## Improved Time and Expense Functionality

The Time and Expense module which was formerly available only for Corporate Claims will be available for Carrier Claims as well.

The Time & Expense toolbar button is displayed on the Reserves screen [Fig. 21] when the Utilities settings for it are configured.

#### **Creating Time and Expense Transactions**

- A Reserve must be created prior to creating a Time and Expense Transaction.
- An Error message will be displayed for both Corporate as well as Carrier Claims if a Reserve is not selected.
- It is mandatory to select a Rate Table to create a Time and Expense transaction.
- An error message "Please select claim rate table to proceed" will be displayed if a Rate Table is not selected.

Once the **Rate Table** and **Currency Type** are selected **[Fig. 21]**, the postable, non-postable, billable or non-billable transaction can be created as required.






There are 3 radio buttons, Billable, Non-billable and Postable, available on the transaction creation popup window. [Fig. 22]

In case, Billable and Postable options are selected, then, the invoice amount will be billed as well as the amount will be deducted from the Reserve.

When the transaction is Non-billable and Non-postable, then, the amount will not be deducted from the Reserve.






Previously, the Insurance RISKMASTER system did not indicate the "Type" of Person Involved displayed on the righthand pane of the Claim screen. The Person Involved was only displayed as PI Other (First Name, Last Name), despite the selection of the Other Person "Type" from the dropdown on the Other Person Involved screen [Fig. 24]. This led to ambiguity as to the "Type" of Person Involved selected for a Claim.




## Admin Tracking Lookup on Case Management Supplemental Screen

Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 offers an option to create Supplemental Fields of Administrative Tracking type. With this new feature, new Record(s) can be searched and selected from the Administrative Tracking Tables.



## Ability to Restrict Access to Claim Types\*

With the release of v.19.2, Insurance RISKMASTER enables the option for restricting certain **Claim Type** for select users.



Once the **Claim Type** is made confidential for a particular user, only the non-restricted Claims will be accessible to the user. The confidential ones will not appear in the search results when the search filter is applied on Claim or Claimant. The Claim information along with Financials of the confidential Claims will be hidden.

The claim restriction will affect Utilities, Maintenance and Claim zone. That is, the restricted claims will be inaccessible from the abovementioned zones.



## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

## Abrogating the Need for Clearing Browser Cache

This release eliminates the need for clearing browser cache whenever a new (future) release or hot patch is deployed on the server. This feature will work on a go forward basis, and hence, customers upgrading from 19.1 or an older version will need to clear their browser's cache once post upgrading to Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2. However, as mentioned every subsequent upgrade (new version / CHP or even a hot patch) would not need clearing cache again.

With the release of v.19.2 and onwards, just refreshing the browser (Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox and Microsoft Edge) will be enough & manual cache clearing will no longer be required.

## Introduction of ODG & Redundancy of Presley Reed

DXC brings onboard ODG by MCG for RTW & MDG and recommends this as the preferred service provider.

Post upgrade from an older version of Insurance RISKMASTER to v.19.2, all existing integration(s) with **Presley Reed** will cease to work. They include the **MDA Guidelines** website **Single Sign On** as well as the **Return To Work Estimates**. Please note that **any direct access to Presley Reed website would remain unaffected**.

#### **Browser Recommendation**

Microsoft Edge Browser v.41.x. currently does not support Disability Guidelines and Medical Disability Guidelines in Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2.

Hence, DXC Technology recommends using Google's Chrome browser for Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2 as Microsoft is in the process of rolling out a Chromium based Edge browser similar to Chrome.



## JSON Web Tokens (JWT)

Following the release of Insurance RISKMASTER v.19.2, all existing JSON Web Tokens (JWTs) issued to Insurance RISKMASTER API users will get disabled. DXC Technology recommends regenerating the tokens for further use.

## Time & Expense Module

To create a new Time & Expense transaction, it is recommended to select the individual Reserve for which a Time & Expense transaction needs to be created.

## **Antivirus Warning**

DXC Technology advises configuring antivirus programs in such a way that they do not interfere with the functioning the Insurance RISKMASTER web application. To address the issue of slowness, it is suggested that appropriate antivirus settings are used for the smooth and lag free use of the Insurance RISKMASTER application.
